Our adoption policies will continue to operate under the following modifications:

- We will be open for customers wishing to adopt for walk through without an appointment effective August 2, 2021. Until that time, please call the shelter for an appointment.
 - Please be aware that we may limit the total number of visitors at any one time and that you may be required to wait if the facility is at capacity.
- Pets may be viewed on our website 24/7. The website is updated hourly and online adoption applications are available.

 - Inaccurate applications, application missing answers, or missing pertinent information will not be considered or will be declined.
 - Once the application has been reviewed and approved, a staff member will be in contact to schedule an appointment so you can meet with the animal.
 - Please be aware that we can only select one applicant for an animal and encourage you to reapply for another animal if your application was not selected for a particular pet.
